The Zoo d'Asson

You can find more animals, including some mad monkeys, amazing birds, and even a tiger at the Zoo d'Asson.

The zoo is run by a family who love to look after animals. The zoo has a collection of 500 animals (100 species) from distant lands such as Asia, South America, tropical Africa, and Australia. There are even paths where you can walk among some amazing creatures. The zoo is open around the year.

Take the D937 out of Lourdes towards Nay and Pau. After passing through Lestelle Betharram turn left onto the D35 and follow the signposts.

The Animal Park of the Pyrenees

The Parc Animalier des Pyrénées to give it its proper name lets you to see the animals which live in this area of France. You might see bears, wolves, chamois, marmots, lynx, roe-deer, otters, foxes, and squirrels, from a safe distance.



There are plenty of things to do in the visitors centre too.

The Animal Park is just down the road in Argeles Gazost, a few miles from the villa, and is open from April to September.

Turn left out of the villa, through Ouzous, and turn right onto the D921b Avenue des Pyrenees. The Animal Park is just off the roundabout a few kilometres down the road.

The Mountain Luge

The Luge is probably the scariest sport at the Winter Olympics hurtling down some seriously steep hills just centimetres from the ground. Now you can try it for yourself!

The Mountain Luge at Hautacam is open winter or summer. Toboggans taking one or two people and are guided down the 860m descent on rails just above the ground.

From the Animal Park roundabout take the D821a and then right onto the D821 around the east of Argeles Gazost and follow the signs to Hautacam. Be prepared for a lot of hairpin bends!
